Disposal Instructions

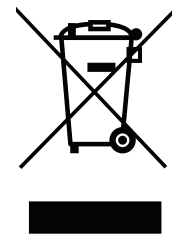
- Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE)

In compliance with the **WEEE Directive (2012/19/EU)**, this product must not be disposed of with unsorted municipal waste. Electronic equipment may contain substances that can pose a risk to the environment or human health if not properly handled.

To Dispose of the Product:

- Return the device to an authorized electronic waste collection point or certified recycling center.
- Alternatively, contact your nearest **FUTEK sales office** for instructions on returning the product for proper recycling.

*Please look for the **crossed-out wheeled bin symbol** on the product or packaging, indicating separate collection and disposal requirements.*



- Battery Disposal and EPR Reporting

The battery included in this device must also be disposed of properly and separately from regular waste.

In compliance with **Battery Directive 2006/66/EC**, used lithium-ion batteries must be collected and recycled appropriately to prevent environmental damage and safety hazards.

To Dispose of the Battery:

- Do not incinerate, disassemble, or dispose of in household trash.
- Take to a designated battery recycling facility or contact your nearest FUTEK sales office.
